<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Determine if the project is eligible for the requested grant program;2. Consider the financial feasibility with the costs that are shown on the application; and3. Perform a general technical review of each project’s scope to evaluate potential problems with fulfilling project phases
All applicants will be invited to the TAC meeting to answer questions about their proposals and become aware of any necessary corrections. Applicants with proposals requiring minor corrections will be notified by TRPC staff and given an opportunity to make minor corrections to their project proposals. Applicants will be notified if their proposal is ineligible, has significant financial costs not accounted for in the application, or has other issues identified during the review. If there are no options to mitigate the problems that are identified, the proposal will be omitted from the call for projects process. | DISCUSSION
