2. Overview of the <i>Hazards Mitigation Plan for the Thurston Region</i> (Paul Brewster)	Brewster gave an overview of hazard mitigation planning, the history of hazard mitigation planning in the region, and the benefits partners can experience by taking part in hazard mitigation.
3. Roles and Responsibilities (Paul Brewster)	<p>Brewster explained the roles and responsibilities of workgroup members, plan partners, and stakeholders. TRPC will work with the workgroup and Thurston County Emergency Management to write the core plan, and partners will have to create and adopt their own annexes to maintain FEMA eligibility.</p> <p>Workgroup members are plan partners and stakeholders, and should look at their own organizations to identify a hazard mitigation planning team. The team will be responsible for representing their agency's interests in the workgroup, providing data and information to support the plan's development, supporting public outreach efforts, and creating their own annexes if participating as a plan partner.</p>
