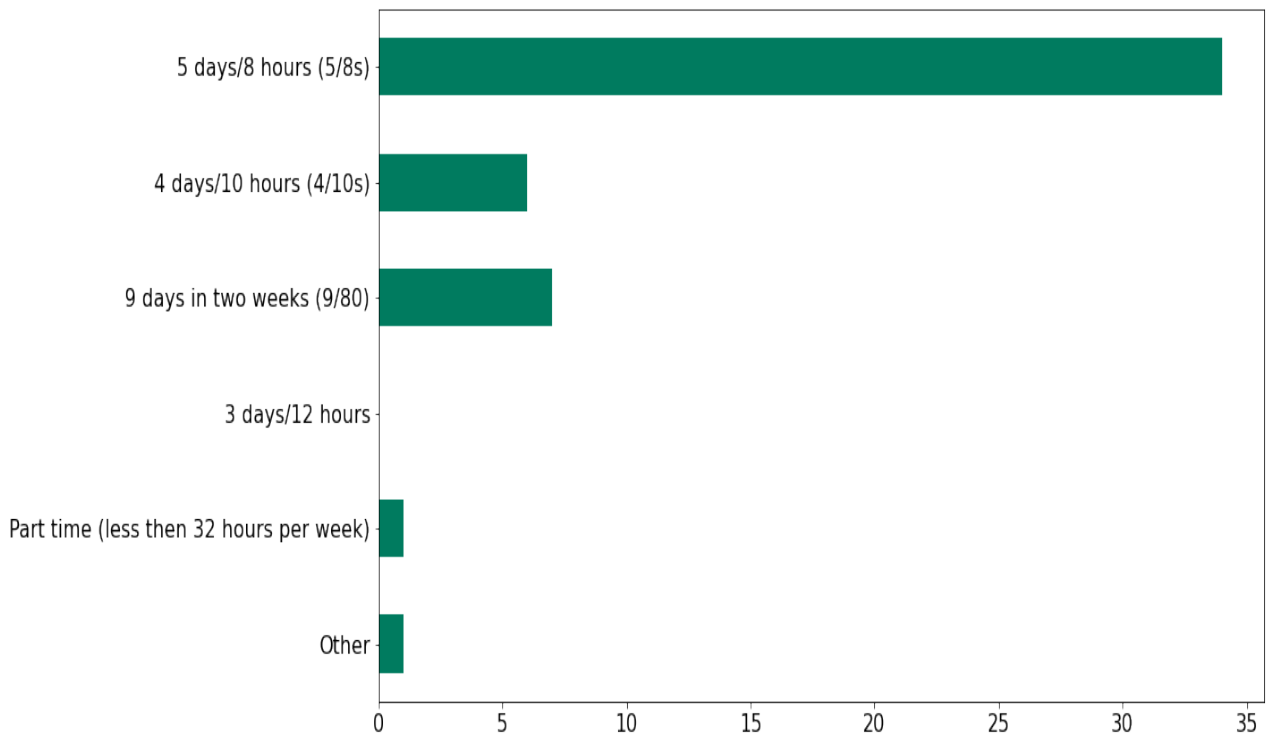

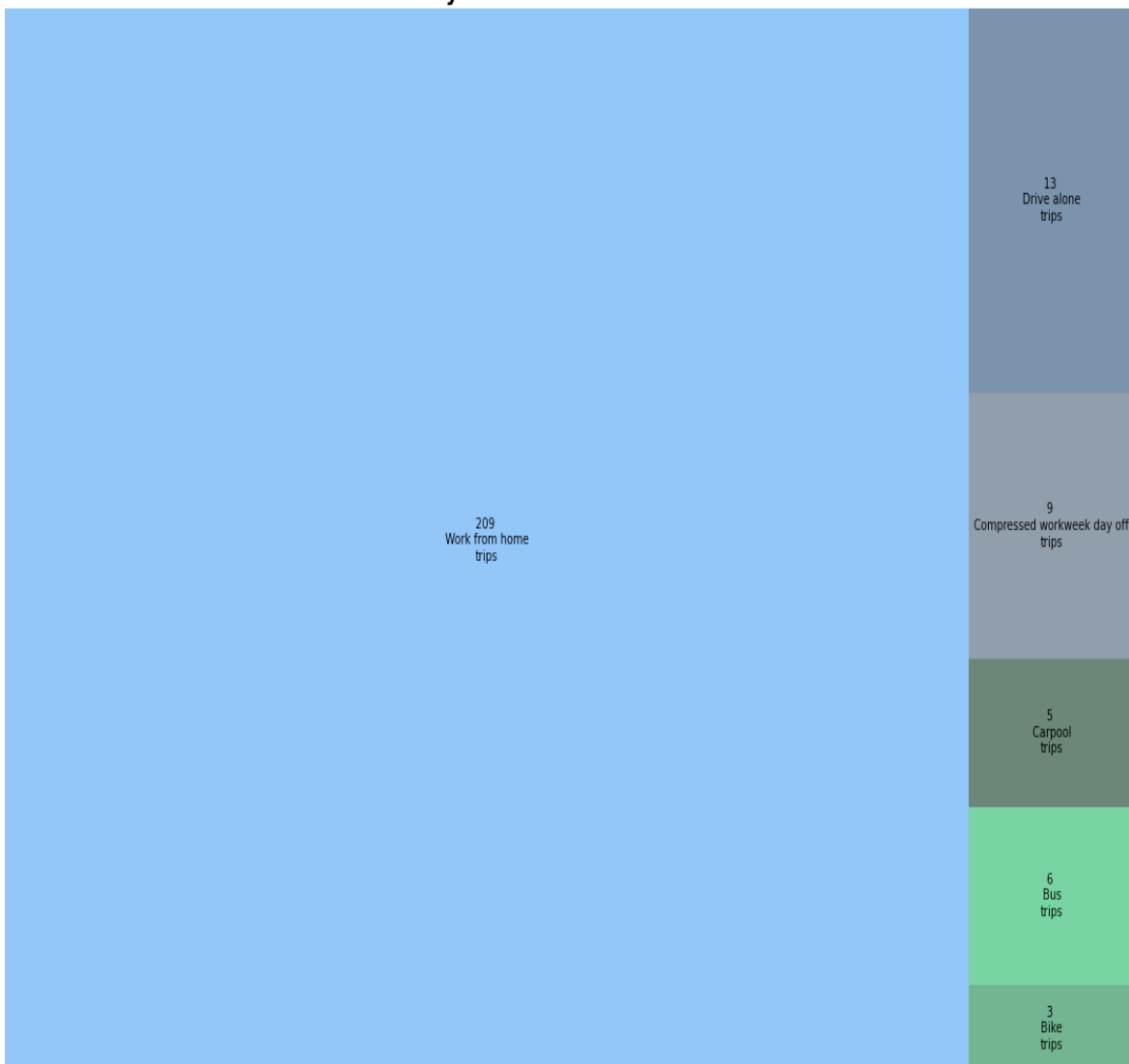

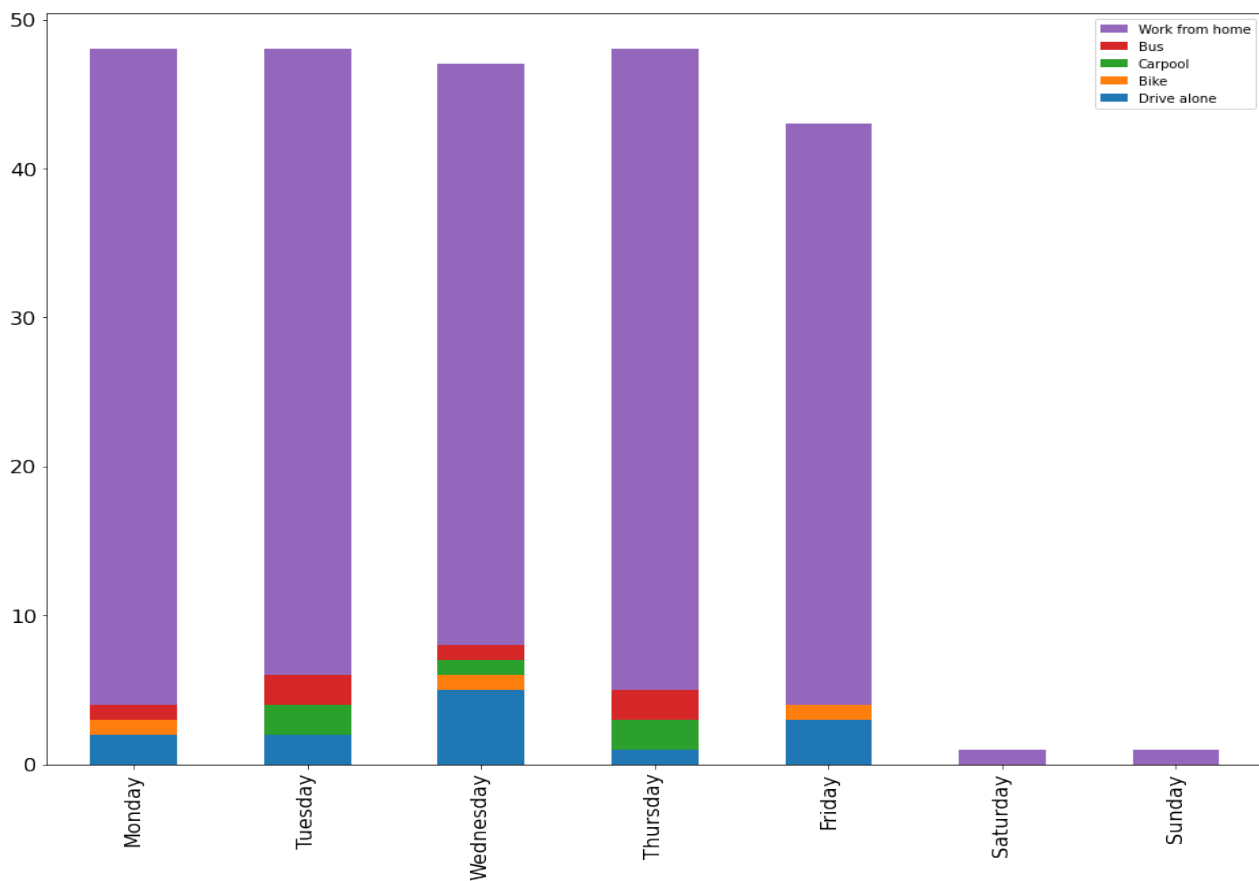

Weekly Commute Modes Selected



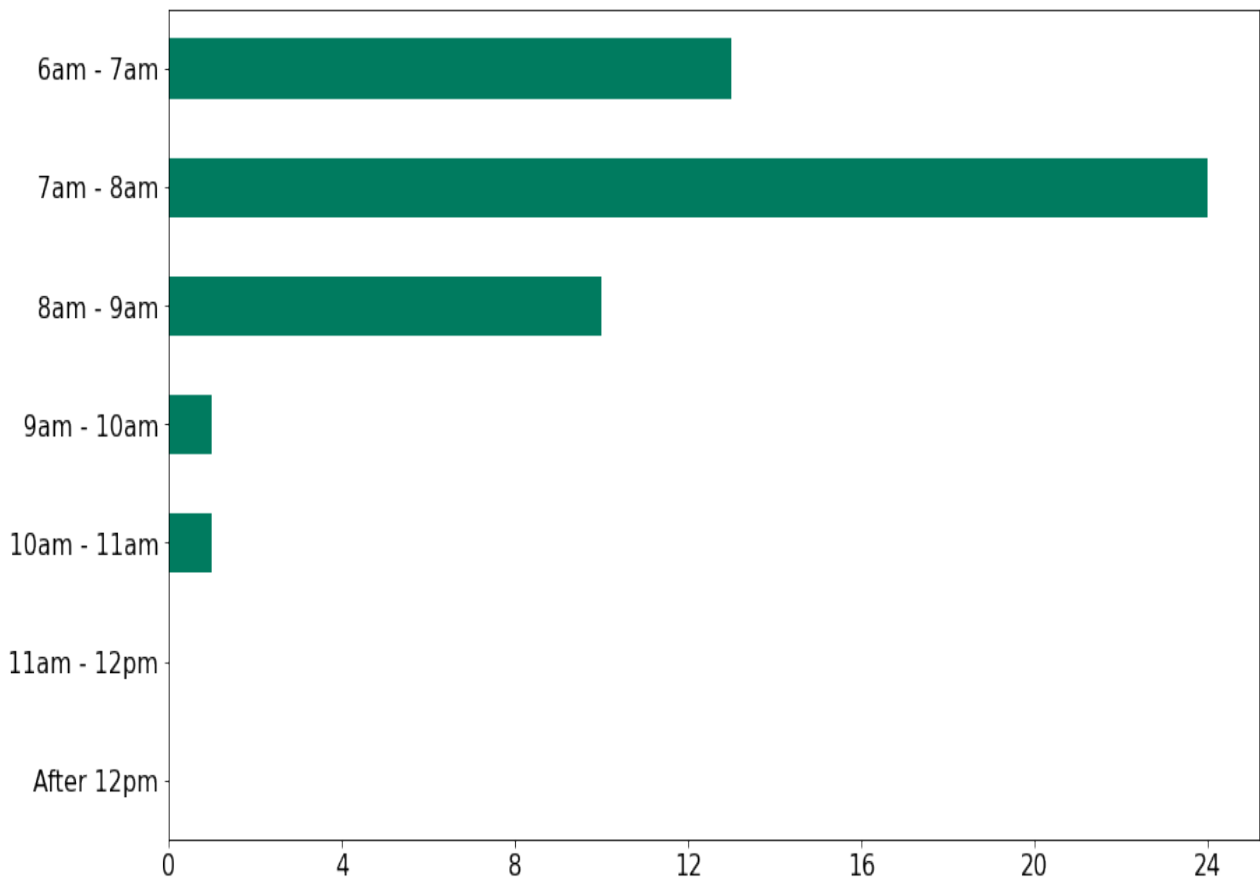

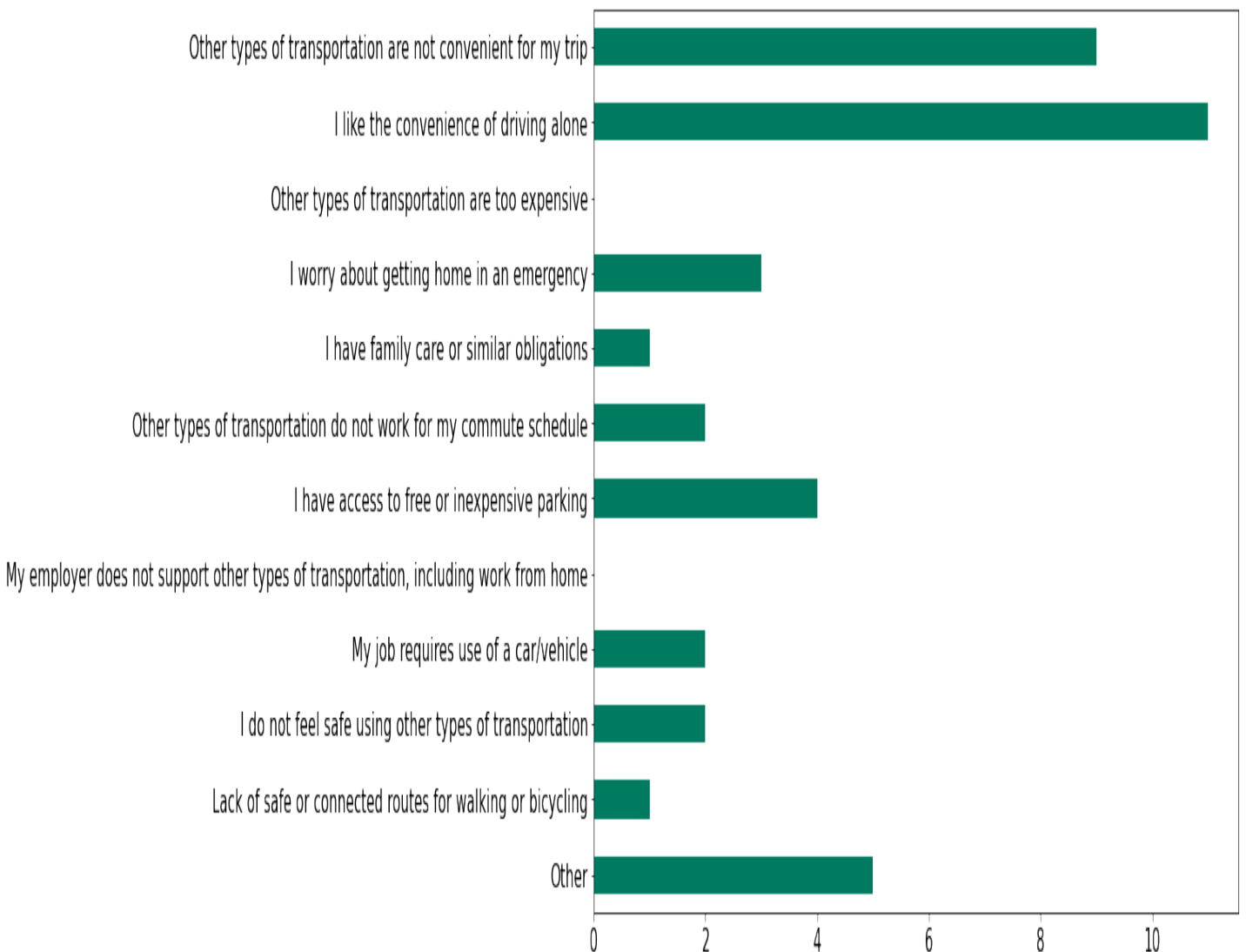
