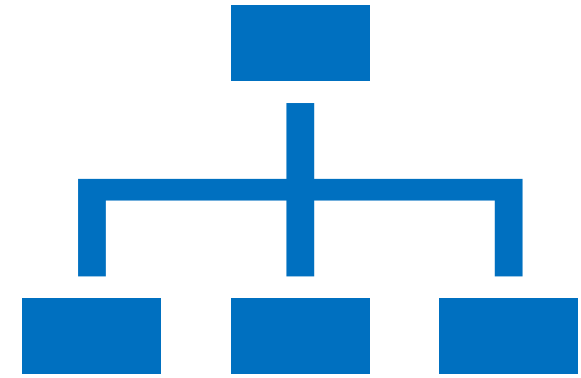

1. Public Engagement



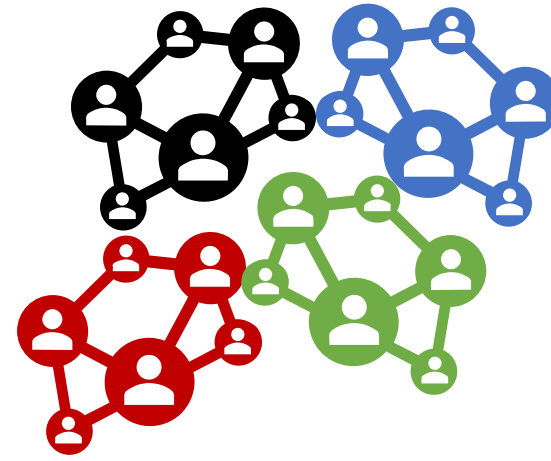
- a. Build publics' Knowledge of recovery and how it differs from response

2. Building Out the Recovery Structure

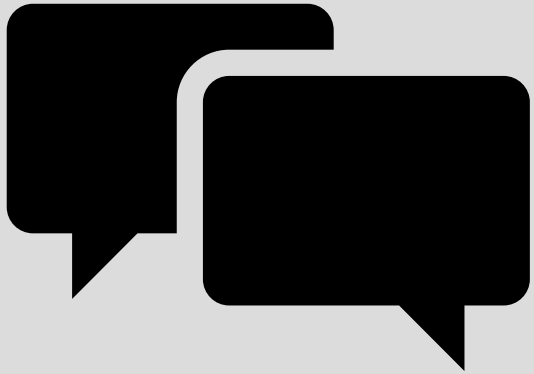


- a. Identify the membership of the Recovery Task Force

3. Ongoing Coordination



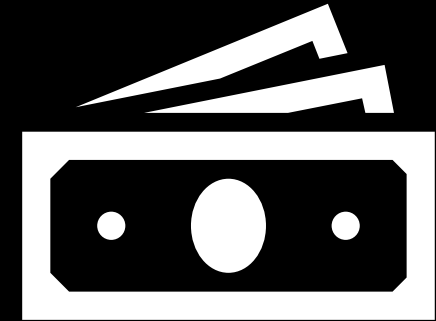
- a. Establish and regularly convene the RTF and RSF Subcommittees. Establish a clear process to select the LDRM.
- b. Establish and maintain a list of organizations in the community that can provide recovery assistance along with their potential resources and capabilities.
- c. Build relationships with the labor force and industries that may be needed for infrastructure recovery.
- d. Train together.
