**SUBJECT:** Commute Trip Reduction on Joint Base Lewis McChord

**PURPOSE**

Update Council about current Commute Trip Reduction outreach and strategies employed at Joint Base Lewis McChord and discuss opportunities for the future.

**Summary:**

- Our state's Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Law affects employers across the state with over 100 employees, and all state agencies in the Thurston County, but what about military installations? Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) has a unique mix of worksites that are affected differently than others in the state.
- Data is currently being gathered and will be presented on where active-duty personnel reside and volume counts on Interstate 5 (I-5). Partners are being engaged about how to implement additional transportation demand management on and near the base.
- Partnerships for marketing the federal mass transit benefit program are being explored with Pierce County and outreach is being done to the South Sound Military and Communities Partnership.
