SUBJECT: State contract for WRIA 13 Deschutes Salmon Recovery Lead Entity Coordination

PURPOSE

1st Reading to obtain Council’s approval for a new agreement with the Washington Recreation and Conservation Office for salmon recovery Lead Entity coordination.

Summary:

- The Deschutes (WRIA 13) Salmon Recovery Lead Entity Program moved to TRPC in September 2018.
- Each year the Washington Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) contracts with the hosts of salmon recovery lead entities to coordinate the work.
- Even though Council has granted the Executive Director the authority to enter into such agreements on behalf of Thurston Regional Planning Council (TRPC), RCO requires that the decision-making body for the host organization, in our case Council, take action each biennium reaffirming that TRPC agrees to host the Lead Entity and contract with RCO for the coordination funding.
- This is the 1st review. The Council will be asked to take action at the June meeting through consent agenda.

REQUESTED ACTION

1st review of Council action to approve that the Executive Director contract with RCO for salmon recovery Lead Entity coordination funding.
